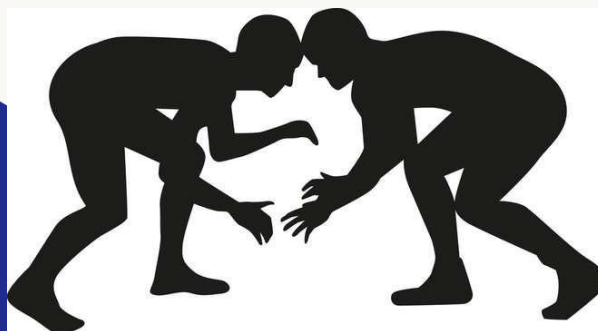

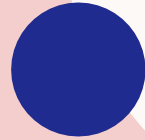

ABOUT KARAGANDA

Karaganda is one of the largest cities in Kazakhstan and an important industrial and cultural center of the country. It is located in central Kazakhstan, in the Karaganda region. The city is known for its rich mining history, especially coal production, which played a major role in its development. Karaganda has wide streets, numerous parks, universities, theaters, and museums.

Today it is a modern city with a balanced rhythm of life, combining industrial significance with cultural traditions and urban comfort.

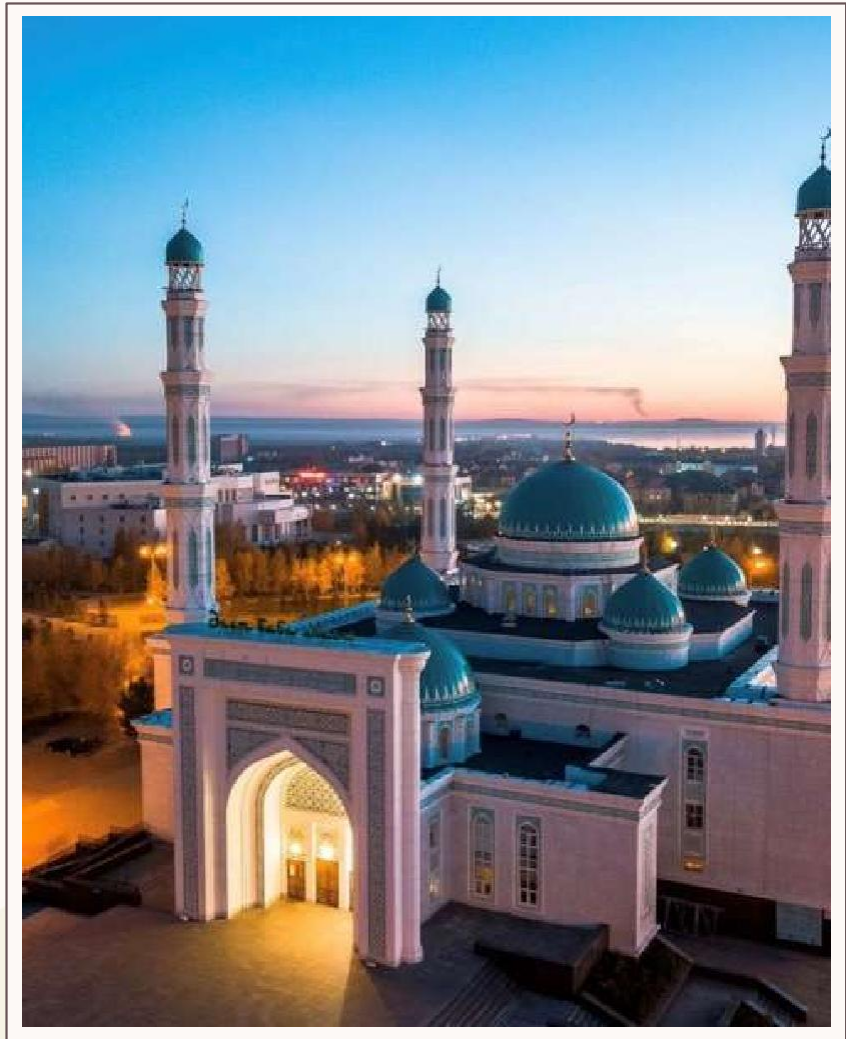


ABOUT KARAGANDA

Karaganda was founded in the 1930s following the discovery of large coal deposits in central Kazakhstan. During the Soviet period, the city developed rapidly as one of the country's major centers of coal mining and heavy industry. In 1934, Karaganda was officially granted city status and became one of the key industrial cities of the Kazakh Soviet Socialist Republic.

During World War II, numerous industrial enterprises and workers were relocated to Karaganda, which significantly contributed to the city's further development. Karaganda is also historically associated with the KarLag labor camp system, an important part of the region's past.

Today, Karaganda is one of the largest cities in Kazakhstan and serves as a major industrial, educational, scientific, and cultural center of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

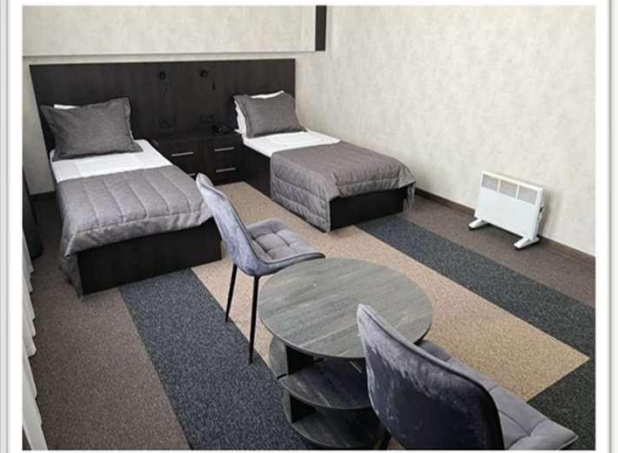

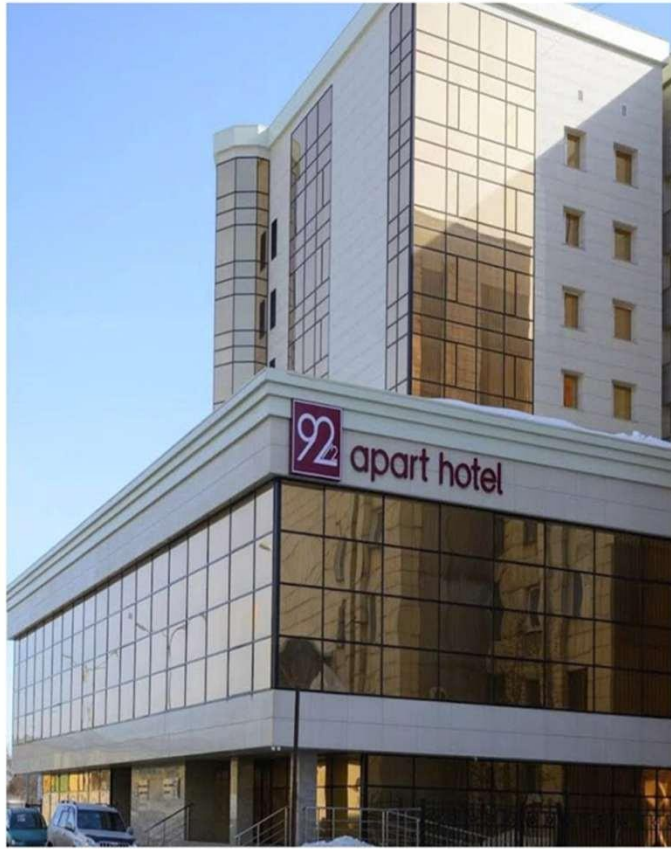

VISA ENTRY

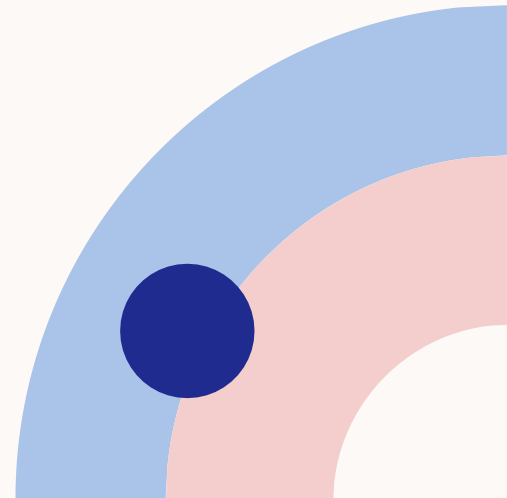
While certain Asian countries may be exempt from visa requirements based on existing bilateral agreements, citizens of other countries may be required to obtain an electronic visa (e-Visa).

Each delegation is fully responsible for verifying whether its members require a visa to enter the Republic of Kazakhstan. Participants are strongly advised to carefully review the official information regarding the visa regime of the Republic of Kazakhstan prior to travel.

Detailed information on the visa regime of the Republic of Kazakhstan is available on the official website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Participants are solely responsible for obtaining the required visas. The Organizing Committee shall not be held responsible in the event that a visa is not granted.

Upon request, the Organizing Committee may issue an official invitation letter to support the visa application process.

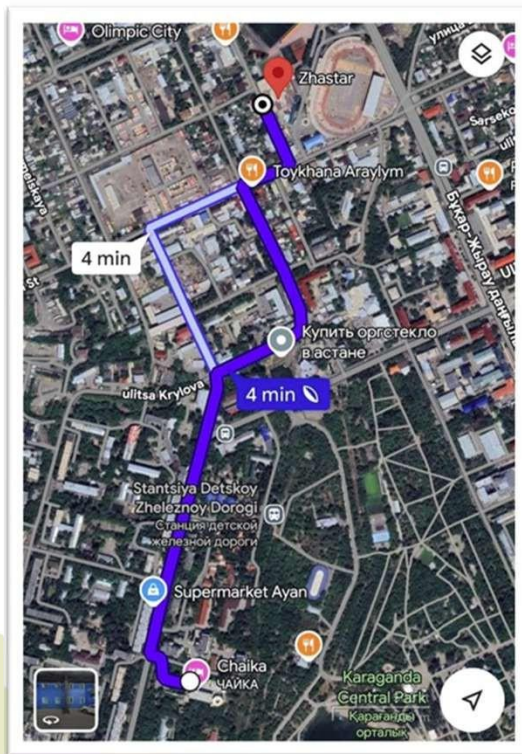
All team representatives will be met by buses at Astana International Airport (Terminal 1). The buses will provide direct transportation for participants from the airport to the official hotels.

Transportation from the hotels to the competition venue and back will be arranged in accordance with the official competition schedule.

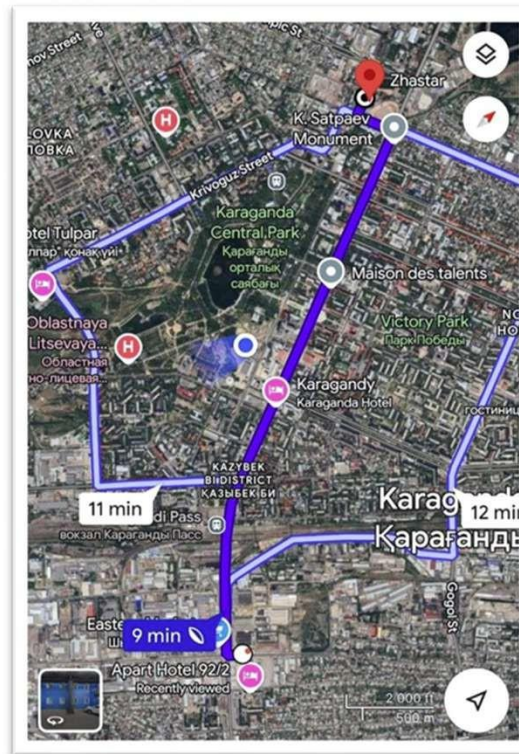


THE DISTANCE BETWEEN HOTELS AND COMPETITION VENUE

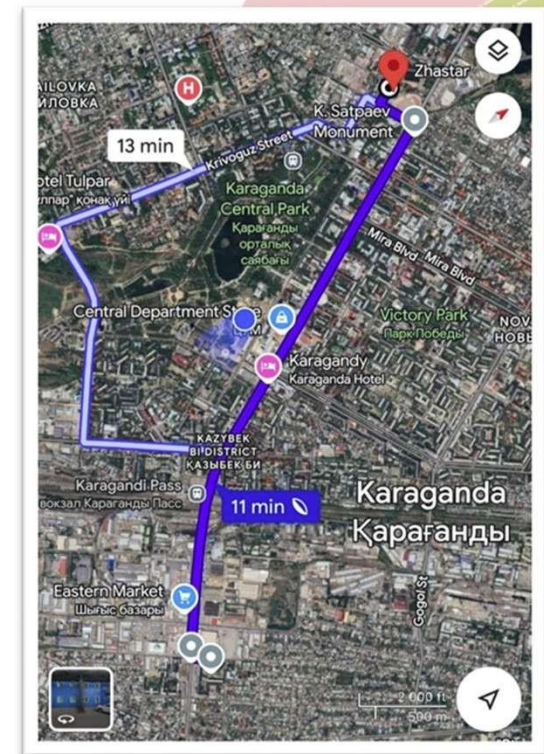
CHAIKA – 1.5 km

USEFUL INFORMATION

Each participating country is required to provide valid insurance coverage for every member of its delegation.

All participants are strongly advised to obtain international travel and accident insurance. The insurance policy must fully cover participation in the championships, including training sessions and official competitions.

The Organizing Committee shall not be held responsible for any medical expenses in the absence of valid insurance coverage.



MEDICAL SERVICE AT THE COMPETITION VENUE

A fully equipped ambulance will be stationed at the competition venue to ensure immediate medical assistance and emergency transfer, if required.

During the championships and official training sessions, qualified medical teams consisting of experienced physicians and paramedics will be present at designated areas of the Field of Play to provide first aid and respond promptly to any injuries or medical emergencies.



OTHER INFORMATION

The official currency of the Republic of Kazakhstan is the Kazakh tenge (KZT). International credit cards such as VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and UnionPay are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, shops, and gas stations. However, due to fluctuations in the currency market, participants are strongly advised to carry a sufficient amount of cash for personal expenses, as cash withdrawals from foreign bank cards may be limited.
