

ABOUT THE CITY

Bishkek is the capital of Kyrgyzstan and the country's largest city in terms of population (over 1 million). The capital of Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek, is the borderline of Central Asia's Tian Shan range. The Kyrgyz Ala-Too mountains and Ala-Archa National Park adorned with wildlife trails and glaciers, concludes the scenic beauty of the place. Bishkek is the modern cultural, political and economic center of the country. It is a quiet city with wide streets and beautiful houses with its own distinctive, measured rhythm of life.

ABOUT THE CITY

Bishkek was founded in 1825 on the ruins of the ancient Pishpek hill fort and the Kokand fortress of Pishpek, which were county trade towns on the caravan route from the 7th to the 13th centuries. The caravans of the Great Silk Road also passed through Bishkek. The rapid development of the city began after 1917. In 1926, in honor of the revolutionary and statesman, Pishpek was renamed Frunze, and then it was renamed back to Bishkek after the fall of the USSR and the gaining independence of the Kyrgyz Republic.



ABOUT THE CITY

Filled with exotic foliage and historic post-Soviet anachronisms, Bishkek is a city engraved with cultural nuances. The vibrant and youthful atmosphere of the place is the reason why the city witnesses a massive tourist turnout every year. The pulsating nightlife of Kyrgyzstan's capital city is unparalleled. ACCOMODATION


- The competitions will be held in the official hotel.
- **Jannat Regency Hotel**
- The hotel is located 37,2 km away from the Manas International Airport. The living costs cover accommodation with 3-time meals.
- In order to ensure the most favorable prices, the OC is directly in charge of the accommodation process for the participants. Single, Twin, and Triple standard rooms will be available. The reservations will be confirmed upon receipt of the Hotel Accommodation Form and the required payment will be provided. The OC will provide official transportation and accreditation only to those who make their booking through the OC. The rates are per night, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner.





VISA

While some Asian countries may be exempt from visas due to the existing agreements concluded between our countries, others can obtain an e-Visa.

Each member of every delegation will be responsible to verify if he needs a visa to enter the Kyrgyz Republic. It is highly recommended that foreigners, who wish to visit the Kyrgyz Republic, should read the related information about our country's visa regime.

An information note about the visa regime of the Kyrgyz Republic is available at the following address: www.evisa.e-gov.kg

The Participants are responsible for asking for the visa and the Organization Committee cannot be responsible if the visa is not obtained. The Organization Committee can send the participants an invitation letter if necessary.



TRANSPORTATION

The OC will provide free transportation service from the Manas International Airport to the hotel (and vice versa) for those who make their hotel reservation through the OC. Airport Transfer Service will be available for the competition period(preliminary).

Manas International Airport is 37 km away and within a 20 – 30 min drive away. Participants will be welcomed at the airport by the OC and accompanied throughout their entire ride.


Any changes in departure details must be submitted to the OC at the venue at least 48 hours before the flight departure.



TRANSPORTATION

The type of transport will be determined once the number of participants will be confirmed. For a small group, the micro bus will carry the delegation, and a larger bus will be enrolled in case a large group of people will confirm their participation.






AIRPORT

INSURANCE

Each country is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. It is recommended that you hold international travel- and accident insurance, please ensure it covers you for competing in the championships



MEDICAL SERVICE AT THE COMPETITION VENUE

At least one ambulance, also heavily equipped, will be staged at the competition venue to facilitate the transfer. In the championships, medical teams consisting of experienced physicians and paramedics will be positioned at designated spots on the Field of Play to act as first responders to injuries or emergencies during the competition or official training sessions.



USEFUL INFORMATION

Local Currency

The local currency is the Kyrgyz Som. Established credit cards like VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Union Pay, Mir (Мир) are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, shops, gas stations etc. Due to unstable situation currency market in Kyrgyzstan, it is highly recommended to bring the own money in cash, as you can face the problem with cashing out the dollars from the card.

Electricity

The electricity supply is 220V.
